Poulshot	2	<u>BRIDLEWAY</u> . Hooks Lane. From the Trowbridge - Devizes road, A.361, on the Rowde Parish boundary south of Lower Foxhangers Farm, leading south and south-west to Barleyhill Lane, U/C 7075, by Barleyhill Farm. Approximate length 950 m. Width 7.6 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 ROUGH FARM TRACK. CAN BE VERY MUDDY
Poulshot	3	<u>BYWAY</u> . Broadway Lane. From Barleyhill Lane, U/C 7075, leading south-west to road U/C 7072 at its junction with road C.244, north-west of Townsend Farm. Approximate length 1200 m. Width 10.7 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 PRETTY PATH , LOTS OF WILDLIFE. ROOKERY, FOXES,ROE DEER,RABBITS, BUT USED BY OFF-ROADERS SO NOT FORT HE FAINT HEARTED. Recently repaired, by the council and is now a firm track..
Poulshot	4	<u>BRIDLEWAY</u> . Byde Mill Lane. From the north-western end of road U/C 7072 leading north-west for about 1006 m towards the Seend Parish boundary at Summerham Brook. Approximate length 1006 m. Width 6.1 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 GOOD TRACK FOR WILDFLOWERS,BUTT ERFLIES, FOXES.UNFORNUNATELY PETERS OUT AT NORTH WESTERN END. CAN BE MUCKY AT VILLAGE END AS LEADS TO COW MILKING SHEDS.

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Poulshot	5	<u>BRIDLEWAY</u> . Hay Lane. From road C.244 on Poulshot Green, south of Green Farm, leading south-east to within about 18 m of the Potterne Parish boundary and continuing south to its junction with Potterne path No.111 towards Five Lanes. Approximate length 1750 m. Width 9.1 m - 12.2 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 VERY GOOD TRACK.IDEAL FOR WALKAFTER PUB LUNCH AS ALMOST OPPOSITE THE RAVEN.LEADS TO NEW IRON BRIDGE(2006) OVER PRETTY STREAM. GOOD FOR BIRDS ESPECIALLY SUMMER VISITORS SUCH AS WHITETHROAT, SEDGE WARBLER, CHIFFCHAFF, WILLOW WARBLER.
Poulshot	6	<u>FOOTPATH</u> . From road C.244, 137 m south of Eastnell Lane, path No.9, leading south to the eastern end of Mill Lane, U/C 7074, at its junction with path No.16. Approximate length 320 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 PASTURE WHERE LIVESTOCK ARE GRAZED.LEADS TO TRACK .LOTS OF RABBITS.

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Poulshot	7	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From Mill Lane, U/C 7074, at the Cottages east of the Church, leading south-east to path No.16, north of Poulshot Mill. Approximate length 251 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 Subject to ploughing PASTURE USUALLY MOWN FOR HAY IN SUMMER.
Poulshot	8	<u>BRIDLEWAY.</u> Leighball Lane. From Broadway Lane, path No.3, opposite path No.28, leading north-west to path No.31. Approximate length 870 m. Width 7.6 m - 9.1 m.	relevant date 12th May 1991 GOOD ROUGH TRACK WITH HIGH HEDGES OF BLACKTHORN HAWTHORN AND WILLOW.EXCELLENT WINTER ROOST FOR REDWINGS AND FIELDFARES.
Poulshot	9	<u>BRIDLEWAY.</u> Eastnell Lane. From road C.244, about 229 m south of Manor House Farm, leading east to path No.17. Approximate length 560 m. Width 9.1 m - 12.2 m.	relevant date 9th July 1991 VERY PRETTY PATH.SADLY VERY OVERGROWN MUCH OF YEAR AND FLOODED NEAR ROAD END IN WINTER.RED CAMPION,STITCHWO RT, BUTTERFLIES,ROE DEER.WALKERS CAN USE PARALLEL PATH IN FIELD.
Poulshot	10	<u>BRIDLEWAY.</u> Sillington's Lane. From road C.244 north of the Council Houses and about 400 m north of Green Farm, leading south-east to path No.18. Note 83m From C.244 is Tarmac, and 160m from C.244 is adopted as road. Approximate length 370 m. Width 6.1 m - 7.6 m.	relevant date 9th July 1991 FIELD TO NO 18 CAN BE VERY DIFFICULT TO NEGOTIATE DUE TO TALLGROWING CROPS IN SUMMER
Poulshot	11	<u>BRIDLEWAY.</u> From the northern end of path No.25 leading west-north-west to Broadway Lane, path No.3. Approximate length 250 m. Width 15.2 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 RUTTED TRACKGOOD FOR BLACKBERRIES.

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Poulshot	13	<u>BRIDLEWAY</u> . Penning Lane. From road C.244 at Poulshot Green, south of the Allotment Gardens, leading north-east and south-east to its junction with Footpath No.20. Approximate length 120 m. Width 12.2 m.	relevant date 24th May 1994 GOOD GRASSY TRACK
Poulshot	14	<u>FOOTPATH</u> . From the north-western end of Barleyhill Lane, U/C 7075, near Barleyhill Farm, leading north-west alongside Summerham Lane, path No.1, to the Trowbridge - Devizes road, A.361, at Summerham Bridge on the Seend Parish boundary. Approximate length 640 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 SEE FOOTPATH NO.1
Poulshot	16	<u>BRIDLEWAY</u> . From the junction of Mill Lane, U/C 7074, with path No.6 leading south to the Poulshot Mill then west and south to the Worton Parish boundary. Approximate length 402 m. Width 3 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 GOOD LONG WALK ACROSS TO WORTON, THEN JOIN 5 LANES PATH BACK TO POULSHOT. MAP ESSENTIAL. DIFFICULT FOR WALKING IN MAY, JUNE AND JULY UNTIL MOWN FOR HAY OR CUT FOR SILEAGE.
Poulshot	17	<u>FOOTPATH</u> . From Eastnell Lane, path No.9, leading south-east to the junction of Hay Lane, path No.5, with path No.20 on the Potterne Parish boundary. Approximate length 366 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 LOVELY MEADOW PATH JINKS RIGHT DOWN TO STREAM AND NEW IRON BRIDGE (2006).

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Poulshot	18	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From the Potterne Parish boundary leading south-west past its junction with Sillington's Lane, path No.10, to Hay Lane, path No.5. Approximate length 594 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 Part subject to ploughing. FIELD CAN BE HARD TO CROSS IN SUMMER IF OILSEED RAPE PLANTED. GOOD WALK TO WHISTLEY LANE THEN UP TO DEVIZES OR OVER TO POTTERNE. MAP RECOMMENDED.
Poulshot	19	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From Hooks Lane, path No.2, leading south-east and south to Barleyhill Lane, U/C 7075, opposite Broadway Lane, path No.3.	relevant date 9th July 1992 WALK UP TOWARDS POULSHOT NURSERIES. GO ALONG RIGHT SIDE OF BUNGALOW. Part subject to ploughing
Poulshot	20	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From Penning Lane, path No.13, leading south-east across path No.21 to the junction of Hay Lane, path No.5, with path No.17 on the Potterne Parish boundary. Approximate length 1.006 km.	relevant date 12th May 1992 Part subject to ploughing LOVELY OLD HAY MEADOW. WILDFLOWER RICH. OVER STILE ALONG HEDGEROW. CAN BE VERY OVERGROWN IN SUMMER. STILE THEN ACROSS TO STREAM.

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Poulshot	21	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From road C.244 by Manor Farm leading east then north-west across path No.20 and east across Hay Lane, path No.5, to the Potterne Parish boundary with a short spur from the Potterne Parish boundary leading north-west to Hay Lane, path No.5. Approximate length 1.189 km.	relevant date 12 May 1992 ACROSS ROUGH PASTURE.OVER STILE TURN LEFT AND FOLLOW LINE OF HEDGE.BADGER SETT NEAR POND. STILE AND PLANK OVER DITCH. NOT EASY TO NEGOTIATE AS ALONG EDGE OF PLOUGHED FIELD.
Poulshot	24	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From road C.244, north of Manor Farm, leading west and north-west across path No.25 to Broadway Lane, path No.3. Approximate length 320 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 BEWARE HORSES. DOGS ON LEADS. HOLIDAY GRAZING FOR WADWORTHS DRAY HORSES.
Poulshot	25	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From Broadway Lane, path No.3, leading north-east across path No.24 to the eastern end of path No.11. Approximate length 594 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 Subject to ploughing PASTURE. SMALL POND, TADPOLES IN EARLY SPRING. FOXES AND RABBITS.
Poulshot	27	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From road C.244, south-west of Belle Vue House, leading north to path No.25. Approximate length 402 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 Part subject to ploughing DAIRY HERD, DOGS ON LEADS.
Poulshot	28	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From Broadway Lane, path No.3, opposite Leighball Lane, path No.8, leading south-east to Poulshot Green. Approximate length 183 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 PASTURE. DOGS ON LEADS IF HORSES GRAZING.NARROW PATH HARD UP ACAINST BRICK WALL TO GREEN.

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Poulshot	29	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From path No.11 leading north-east at the top of the bank alongside Broadway Lane, path No.3, to path No.28. Approximate length 155 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 GRASSY TRACK.
Poulshot	30	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From Broadway Lane, immediately south of path No.11, leading south-east parallel to path No.11 to path No.25. Approximate length 201 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 PASTURE LAND,WALK ALONG HEDGEROW. ABOUNDS WITH RABBITS
Poulshot	31	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From the north-western end of Leighball Lane, path No.8, leading north-west to the Seend Parish boundary at Summerham Brook. Approximate length 229 m. Width 0.3 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 LOVELY VIEWS SLOPING FIELD SIDE TRACK. OVER DOG FRIENDLY IRONWORK STILE. LEADS OFF TO STILE ON RIGHT THEN LEFT TO BRIDGE.STEEP CLIMB UP PASTURE LAND TO INMARSH NEAR SEEND.
Poulshot	33	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> Canal Towing Path. From the Seend Parish boundary leading east-south-east along the northern bank of the Kennet and Avon Canal to the Rowde Parish boundary west of Lower Foxhanger's Farm. Approximate length 256 m.	relevant date 12th May 1992 GRAVEL PATH, FLAT AND EASY WALKING. GOOD FOR BIKES & PUSHCHAIRS.LOOK OUT FOR HERONS, MALLARD,WATER VOLES AND FISHERMEN.
